Trees are Superheros

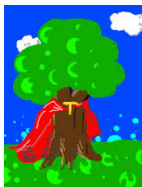

Growing Works of Art Contest if you choose!

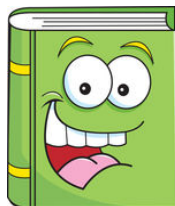


Picture Books

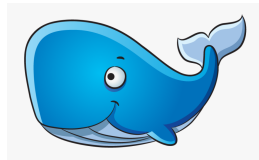
